2. SCR \#\#20 Poetry Contest Theme,"I Spy With My little Eye Something Green Outside"- Celebrating Our Green World.Grades K-9, Special Ed \& students in ESL programs. Poems don't have to rhyme. Use Form \#1
3. Youth Sculpture Contest SCR \#21- Grade 4-8 Sculptures must consist of recyclable, reused and reduced materials. Width no more than $81 / 2 \times 11$ inches. Two 4X6 photographs are recommended. Submit with SCR Youth Sculpture Entry Form.
4. Smokey Bear \& Woodsy Owl Poster contest. Conservation message: "Lend a Hand, Care for the Land." size 11X 14 inches. Smokey Bear message "Only You Can Prevent Forest Fires" The colors of their clothing need to be accurate. Fill out Form \# 1 and attach to the back of the poster. Grade 1-5 attach Form \#1 to back of the poster.
5. TX Garden Club environmental poster : Ruby Throated Hummingbird. Grade 1-6 eligible-Original art size: 11X 17 or 12X18- Grades 1-5. Attach Form \#1 to back of poster.
